INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is St Anne's Edgeside Church of England Primary School
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of St Anne's Edgeside Church of England Primary School"
4. The school has a trust deed
5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 2 parent governors
 - (b) 1 local authority governor
 - (c) 1 staff governor
 - (d) 1 headteacher
 - (e) 7 foundation governors
6. The total number of governors is: 12
7. Those entitled to appoint foundation governors are:
 - (a) the Diocesan Board of Education who appoint 1 governor
 - (b) the Parochial Church Council of the Parish, ecclesiastical district or Team Ministry within which the school is for the time being situated who appoint 5 governors
8. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:
the Principal Officiating Minister
- (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in

(a) above, in the event that that ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his governorship exists, or the ex-officio governor has been removed from office under Regulation 21(1) of the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2003

9. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor

10. The ethos statement of this voluntary school is:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 23 September 2016
12. This instrument was made by order of Lancashire local authority on 22 September 2016
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), and to trustees and all bodies which appoint foundation governors
