Ideas for learning at home!

Literacy and Phonics

This week, why not make a miniature garden? You need a pot or a box and some soil to start. Get your child to design the garden, colour and label all the different parts. Can you include a water feature? A path? Remember to slow speech down to hear the different sounds in words. You can use real plants, ones made from junk/craft items or even Lego! Add your vegetable tops, weeds, stones and some of your small world figures. Remember to water any plants and watch them grow. Can you write a sentence each day about it?

Remember to take photographs and share them on the school's Facebook page or bring them in to show me when we get back to school.

Ceebeebies have lots of resources for reading, look out for Alphablocks and Bedtime Stories.



Mathematics

Look for opportunities for problem solving in maths - there's loads just in every day life! Working our 'how many altogether' and 'how many more' can be fun! Ask lots of questions like, 'We have three apples but we need five, how many more do we need?' Or, 'There's five of us for tea and we need a knife and a fork each, how many pieces of cutlery do we need?'

Baking is great for mathematical development; weigh and measure ingredients, divide into equal groups, set oven temperature, time baking, how long does it take to eat?!



RE/Topic

As you play in the garden or go for your daily exercise look out for signs of animals in their natural habitat. Spider webs are a great place to start and turning over logs and stones to see where they live. Remember to put things back and look after them! In RE we would be looking at journeys and special places. Talk about places that are special to you and why they are special.
