Maths

In Autumn 1 we will be focusing on:

Number and place value- counting up to 19 with groups of 10, finding one more and one fewer and comparing quantities to 20.

Measurement, length and mass- we will be looking at measuring the length, height and mass of objects using standard and non-standard forms of measurement.

Addition and subtraction-we will be looking number bonds/families, adding 2 numbers by counting on as well as adding and subtracting tens and ones.

Geometry and 3D shapes- we will be looking identifying the names and properties of various 2D and 3D shapes.

Topic/Creative Curriculum

In the Autumn 1 we will be looking at aerial photographs and maps of the school and local areas in **Geography**; learning how to draw a map and plot a route.

In **Art** we will be looking at sculptures by artist Darren Jackson and creating our own penguin images and 3D sculpture of a penguin.

In **Music**, we are also going to be learning about tempo and the basics of using musical instruments to tell a story through sound in music using Hey You!

English

This Autumn our theme is
"Penguins Possums and Pigs"

We will be looking at the story 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers and learning how to sequence and innovate a story through story maps, role play and writing. We will also be looking a poetry and non-chronological reports related to our theme.

Science

During Autumn 1 we are looking at the changes in season around us, describing the various weather patterns and changes in the world around us as we move through the seasons .

R.E

During Autumn we will be looking at the Harvest festival, where it came from, why we celebrate it, how we can help those who have had a bad harvest and its significance in the Christian faith as well as how it is celebrated in Judaism.

Computing

This term we will be learning how to log on to Purple Mash and use the internet safely. We will explore how to use the mouse and keyboard to input data as well as identifying different forms of technology.

P.S.H.E

In Autumn 1 our focus in PSHE is on our health and wellbeing. We will learn why we have rules and how they keep us safe, what it means to be a good listener, to learn about our feelings and those around us and their effects on our bodies as well as what it means to be a good friend.
