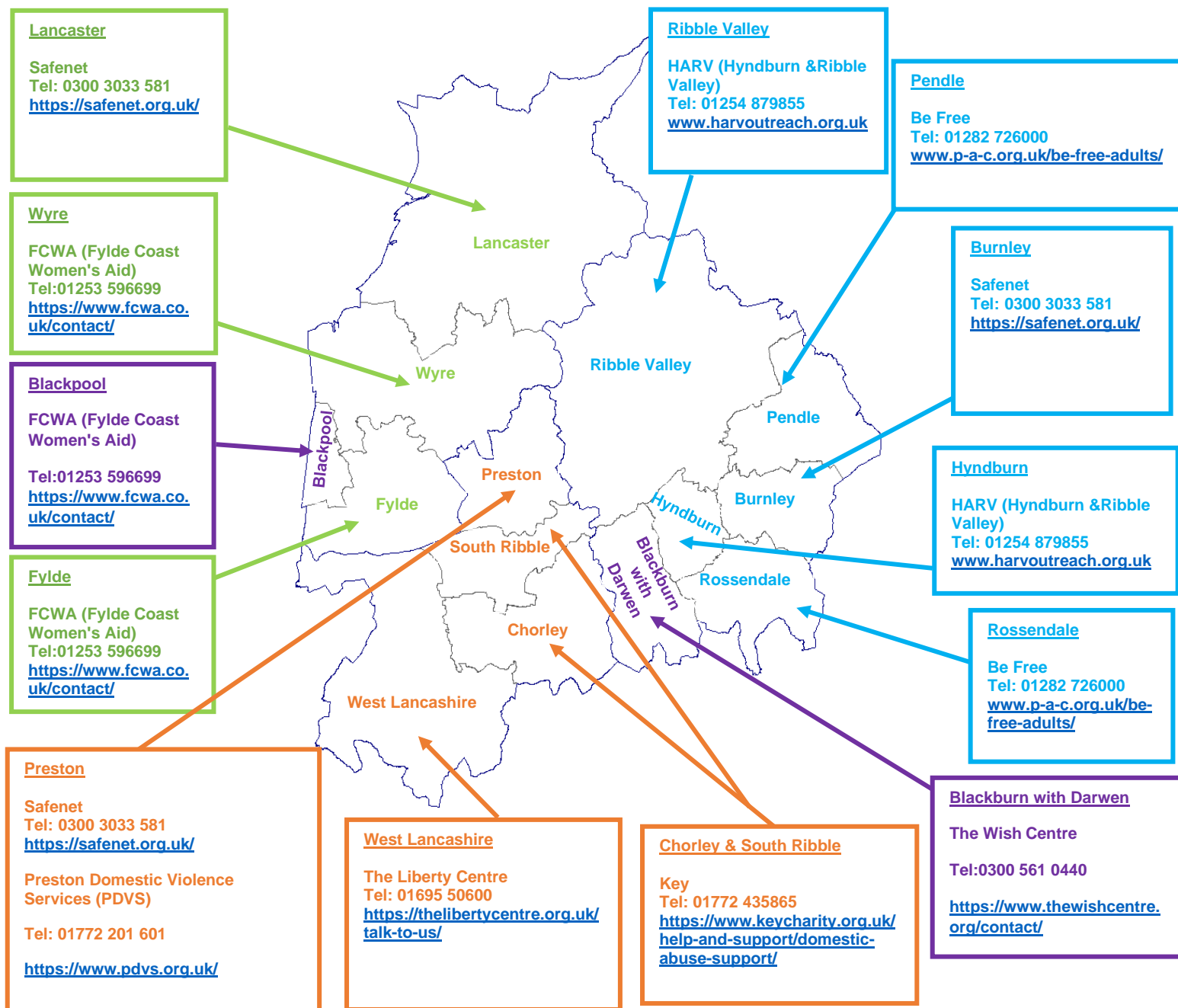


The approach across Lancashire is to offer victims and survivors choice and control over the services offered to them. Below is not an exhaustive list and other services may be available.
