

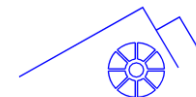

Mathematics

Over the duration of the term we will be covering many areas in Mathematics including:

- Place Value
- Addition & Subtraction
- Multiplication & Division
- Time
- 3D shapes
- Fractions

These topics build on the skills learned during the Autumn term. There is also a focus on recalling times tables up to 12x12 in year 4 in preparation for the year 4 multiplication check later in the year.

Physical Education

Over the Autumn term children in Year 4 will participate in PE lessons learning Dance and Teamwork & Problem Solving. The children will have their lessons delivered by Coach Liam and a dance teacher from Fusion.

Religious Education

In RE we will be exploring the Hindu topic of 'What does it mean to be a Hindu today?' looking closely at the celebration of Diwali and how this links to the idea of dharma. Also, we will be looking why the day Jesus died is called Good Friday.

P.S.H.E

Over the term, children will be covering 'Keeping myself safe' and 'Rights and Responsibilities'
We will enjoy time to discuss a range of situations and learn to listen to others.

English

This term we will be studying a range of text types including persuasive text and stories with an issue or dilemma using a 'Matter of Loaf and Death' (Wallace & Gromit). During Spring 2 term, we will be learning how to write a novel with a theme and a non-chronological report about a given country.

Throughout all of the above, children will continually develop their knowledge of grammar, spelling and punctuation. Handwriting tasks will be completed during guided reading and practised across all subjects.

Computing

This term in computing we will be learning about programming and creating repetition in shapes and then later in the term learning about data logging in our 'Data and Information unit'.

Creative Curriculum

In Geography we will be exploring a contrasting region in a European Country (Spain) and looking at how we can be sustainable with a focus on recycling and our environment.

In Music lessons, children will continue to have their cornet music lesson provided by the Lancashire Music Service. All trumpets are now available to go home (with parental consent) but must be returned back to school on the Thursday before their lessons on Friday.

Spanish lessons will focus on 'Do you have a pet?' for the first half term, and 'At the cafe' for the second half term.

Things to remember and to know about Year 4:

Children who read regularly, quiz regularly and this motivates reading. Please encourage your child to read for at least 10 minutes each night and sign their reading record. **Reading Stars** for that week will be awarded 10 minutes extra playtime and a biscuit treat.

All children are given a **raffle ticket** every time they complete an Accelerated Reader quiz to be entered into a raffle prize at the end of each half term.

Homework is sent home at the beginning of each half term and will have a return date on it.

PE kits need to stay in school at all times (even when participating in afterschool activities).
