Mathematics

Over the duration of the term we will be revising many areas of mathematics including:

- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Mental and written calculation
- Ratio and proportion
- Coordinates, translation and reflection
- Algebra and sequences
- Measurement

English

In English, we will be studying a range of text types including: a narrative based on 'The 1000-Year-Old Boy', our non-fiction units will be discussions and debates and our poetry unit will focus on classical poems.

Throughout all of the above, children will continually develop their knowledge of grammar, spelling and punctuation, whilst handwriting tasks will be completed during Guided Reading and practised across all subjects.

Science

Over the summer term, in science we will be exploring studying animals including humans. Our focus will be on the circulatory system and human anatomy.

Whilst completing this unit we will research famous scientists and their contributions to the world of science.

Physical Education

Over the term, children in Year 6 will participate in PE lessons on Thursdays. Please ensure children have suitable kit for this.

During Summer half-term 1, children will explore hockey and rounders with Coach Liam.

During Summer half-term 2, children will take part in cricket and athletics physical education lessons.

Computing

In Computing, we will be exploring programming through the unit 'Sensing Movement' and also creating media '3D modelling'. Throughout the sessions, we will be discussing e-safety and the importance of staying safe online.

Religious Education

In R.E we will be commencing our Archie Bishop – Young Leaders award, more information is to follow regarding fund raising activities.

Through this unit, children will further develop their understanding of Christianity and other world faiths.

Design and Technology – we will be looking at developing our cookery skills, making and sampling a selection of foods.

Art and design – over the term, we will be exploring landscapes inspired by the work of William Turner.

History – history lessons will aim to develop children's understanding of the Transatlantic Slave Trade.

Geography – during the term we will be studying human geography, land use and economic activity whilst focusing on coastal areas of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Music – over the term will be exploring the unit 'Music and Me!' as we prepare to perform at the next St Anne's music concert.

Spanish

We will continue to develop our understanding of Spanish through speaking, listening to, reading and writing Spanish. Over the term we will study the planets and habitats.

P.S.H.E

Over the term children will be covering a range of topics including 'Being My Best' and 'Growing and Changing'.

We will enjoy time to discuss a range of topics and continue to learn to listen and respect others.

Things to remember and to know about Year 6:
